The detailed flowchart of GFCM along with the key stakeholders involved, their responsibilities, and procedure upto the issuance of Grow Forest Certificate is enclosed.

Moreover, National Forest Policy (NFP), 2018 also talks about climate change mitigation through sustainable forest management. The draft policy document also talks about degraded land and how it can be improved by undertaking afforestation activities using public private partnership models.

Hence, It is requested that this innovative concept can be included under Green India Mission or CAMPA under National Action Plan on Climate Change. Our Association shall be partner to create an enabling legal and regulatory framework to allow private / social sector to work on degraded forest on right to use basis.
